GENERATE A SHEET IN A PDF FILE

Possibles causes:

Our proposed solution:

The PDF file generated by See XP is not in vectorial format, but in Bitmap format.
Therefore this PDF file has a greater size that the one of a standard PDF file.

To generate a PDF file, click the command "File/Print/Standard Screen Shot".
 Select the file type and click on "Properties" to modify the parameters of generation.

It is possible to protect the generated PDF file as well.
 The protection parameters are stored in the properties.

"Owner Password"

This password must contain 6 characters at least.

This option allows generating a PDF file which the user can **only view**. This PDF file cannot neither be printed nor modified.

A password is requested for the PDF file to be generated. On the other hand, no password will be requested when you open this file.

"User Password"

This password must contain 6 characters at least.

After having defined the owner password, the user can define the user password.

This password allows generating a PDF file by authorizing or interdicting its modification, printing, copying or adding comments to it.

Upon opening of the PDF file, you must enter the owner password. One must not communicate to others his user password.
